Customer Inspection & Decision: If declared non-repairable by Parth, the customer will be invited to our factory for physical verification before taking the final decision. Applicable Charges: Service charges will apply for the inspection process, and all transportation/freight costs remain the customer's responsibility.	RMUs beyond repair will be declared after joint inspection from TPCODL & Repairing agency. Only transportation charges will be paid in this case.

The quoted prices are budgetary and indicative in nature and shall not be considered firm, as the actual extent of damage to the RMU can only be determined after opening and dismantling the sealed SF₆ gas tank. Once the tank is opened, a detailed inspection of all internal components will be carried out. The final repair cost will depend on the actual condition of the RMU's internal parts. If the internal components are found to be in good condition, the final repair cost may be lower than the quoted price. However, if extensive damage is observed—particularly to the vacuum interrupters (vacuum bottles), main copper busbars, or other critical components—the final repair cost may exceed the quoted price. Accordingly, the final price shall be determined only after complete dismantling and inspection of the RMU and will be communicated for approval before undertaking any additional repair work.
